



TANGO AND SAMBA

Argentina and Brazil

14 days / 11 nights

DAY 1 (Saturday) DEPARTURE

Evening Flight from several airports to Buenos Aires, the capital of Argentina and the administrative, economic and cultural center of the country. The town lies on the Mouth of the River Rio de la Plata, where the rivers Paraná and Uruguay River meet to the Atlantic Ocean, on the east coast of Argentina. The inhabitants of the city are "porteños" -residents of the port.

DAY 2 (Sunday) BUENOS AIRES

Reception at the airport by our cooperation partner and drive to the hotel for registration. We eat lunch there. PM-city tour of the metropolis. Buenos Aires is an elegant and modern city full of contrasts. We will visit the 'barrios' (neighborhoods) of Palermo and San Telmo. Then we visit the historic Playa de Mayo -May square- with the government buildings, the old town hall (Cabildo) and the Metropolitan Cathedral. Continue to La Boca, an Italian embossed waterfront and one of the most famous in the city. Because of its brightly colored painted houses became a tourist attraction. Then we visit the famous street "El Caminito". This is followed by a visit to the Recoleta Neighbourhood, where the famous Cemetery Recoleta with the graves of many famous people including Evita is located. Dinner at a local restaurant. Back to the hotel **(B) (L) (D)**

DAY 3 (Monday) BUENOS AIRES

Breakfast at the hotel. Today we will experience a real "Fiesta Gaucha". This full day excursion will take us through the Argentinean pampas to an "estancia" (land farm) and includes a barbecue with drinks. This is the ideal opportunity to get the real Argentine life and a good start in "La Tierra de gauchos". Lunch with Argentinean beef, practically straight from the slaughterhouse, accompanied by Argentine Folklore and a gaucho show. After eating opportunity to explore the estancia. Return to the hotel. Overnight at hotel **(B) (L) (D)**

DAY 4 (Tuesday) BUENOS AIRES

Breakfast at the hotel. Full day excursion to the Delta del Tigre. In the evening, we go to a local restaurant with a tango show. Back to the hotel. Overnight. **(B) (D)**

DAY 5 (Wednesday) BUENOS AIRES - FOZ DE IGUAZU

Breakfast at the hotel. Early transfer to the airport for your flight to Iguazu Falls. Reception at the airport by our cooperation partners and to the hotel on the Brazilian side of the falls. The rest of the day is at leisure. Dinner at the hotel **(B) (D)**

DAY 6 (Thursday) IGUAZU

Breakfast at hotel. Trip to the falls on the Argentine side. While mainly on the Brazilian side you can enjoy the panoramic view of the waterfalls, you can hike on the Argentinian side very close between isolated waterfalls. Highlight is the visit to the so-called Garganta del diablo, "Devil's Throat" where the water by a deafening noise from three sides falls 82 meters into the depths. Lunch. In the afternoon, we drive back to the hotel. Dinner and overnight at the hotel. **(B) (L) (D)**

DAY 7 (Friday) IGUAZU - RIO DE JANEIRO

Breakfast at hotel. Today we visit the Brazilian side of the falls. Beautiful panoramic views offer the best impression on the overall extent of this unique natural spectacle. Lunch. Transfer to the airport for your flight to Rio de Janeiro. Upon arrival, reception by our partners and transfer to the hotel. Dinner and overnight at the hotel. **(B) (D)**

DAY 8 (Saturday) RIO DE JANEIRO

Breakfast at hotel. Full day excursion to Rio. Our first destination is the statue of Christ, which was recently chosen as one of the seven modern wonders of the world. The statue is located 697 m. above sea level, atop Corcovado Hill. After a scenic drive along the Rodrigo de Freitas Lagoon, we will arrive at the foot of the hill where we climbed the beautiful mountains on a small train. Once on top, you will experience and discover a panoramic view of Rio de Janeiro and learn why it is called the "Cidade Maravilhosa" "marvelous city"! Little break for lunch at a local restaurant. The rest of the day is at leisure. Overnight at hotel **(B) (L) (D)**

DAY 9 (Sunday) RIO DE JANEIRO

Breakfast at hotel. Trip to Sugar Loaf. More than a million tourists each year visit the world famous Pão de Acucar (Sugar Loaf), which is an iconic symbol of the city of Rio de Janeiro. The Sugar Loaf is located on a small peninsula at the entrance of Guanabara Bay. It carries this name because its shape is reminiscent of a sugar loaf. The first cable car takes passengers to the top of Urca Hill, which rises 215 meters above sea level and offers spectacular views over the bay and its islands. From Urca Hill, we will continue going up in a second cable car to the summit of the Sugarloaf Mountain, which rises 395 meters above sea level and offers a 360-degree view of the entire city including Botafogo and Copacabana beaches, Corcovado and downtown Rio. Lunch on the way. Back at the hotel. Overnight at hotel **(B) (L) (D)**

DAY 10 (Monday) RIO DE JANEIRO - BÚZIOS

Breakfast at the hotel. In the morning, we drive to Buzios in private service with tour guide. Búzios is known, since the "discovery" by Brigitte Bardot and Jacques Cousteau in 1964, formerly a sleepy fishing village, as "the pearl of the Costa do Sol" (Sun Coast), 170 km east of Rio de Janeiro. Tourism has become the most important economic sector before fishing. In Brazil had only Foz do Iguaçu and five million-cities (Rio de Janeiro, Sao Paulo, Salvador, Recife and Brasilia) more foreigners' nights as the little Buzios. Among Brazilians, Buzios is consider elitist. The center is located on a 16-acre, hilly peninsula. Around the peninsula are 25 beach coves, which are among the most beautiful in Brazil. Overnight stay in a pousada **(B)**

DAY 11 (Tuesday) BÚZIOS

Breakfast at hotel. The whole day is at leisure. You can enjoy the beautiful beaches of the area. Overnight at Pousada **(B)**

DAY 12 (Wednesday) BÚZIOS

Breakfast at hotel. The whole day is at leisure. You can enjoy the beautiful beaches of the area. Overnight at Pousada **(B)**

DAY 13 (Thursday) BÚZIOS - RIO DE JANEIRO

Breakfast at hotel. The day is at leisure until timely transfer to the airport for your flight home. **(B)**
