ANDES ROUNDTRIP

Crossing the Andes between Argentina and Chile

15 days / 13 nights

DAY 1 (Friday) INTERNATIONAL FLIGHT TO BUENOS AIRES

Departure from selected airport to Buenos Aires.

DAY 2 (Saturday) BUENOS AIRES

Upon arrival in Buenos Aires, transfer from the airport to the hotel and room distribution. In the afternoon, discover the city of Buenos Aires. Visit the center with the stunning National Congress and Mayo Square (Plaza de Mayo) surrounded by the Government House (Casa Rosada), the Metropolitan Cathedral and the old town hall from the colonial period (Cabildo). Visit the Colon Theater, one of the most prestigious opera houses in the world and the cultural pride of the "porteños" (natives of Buenos Aires). Proceed through the traditional "Barrio San Telmo" (district of San Telmo) where the magical atmosphere of the neighborhood brings us back in time (on Sunday you can also visit the flea market). Stop in La Boca, home to the first Italian immigrants and famous for its picturesque and colorful architecture. Then, the tour continues through the residential area of Palermo and its parks. Then we visit La Recoleta, the most exclusive area of the city with its famous market where the remains of Evita are buried, elegant boutiques, gourmet restaurants and sidewalk cafes under rubber trees (*Ficus elastica*). At night, we eat in a typical restaurant in town with a whole tango show. Overnight in Buenos Aires. **(B) (D)**

DAY 3 (Sunday) BUENOS AIRES

The whole day is at leisure or for optional excursions such as by ferry across the Rio de la Plata to Montevideo. (Costs with ferry, city tour and lunch in Montevideo about € 130.-). Good opportunity for shopping. Overnight in Buenos Aires **(B)**

DAY 4 (Monday) BUENOS AIRES - BARILOCHE - HUEMUL ISLAND - LLAO LLAO - BARILOCHE

Transfer to the local airport (Aeroparque) for your flight to Bariloche. Reception at the airport and transfer to your hotel. In the afternoon, city tour, among others, Playa Bonita from where it is possible to see the Huemul Island. Later, visit of Campanario Hill. Opportunity to ride the cable car to the mountaintop (optional). Then it is on to visit the Llao-Llao Peninsula, from where Puerto Pañuelo can be seen. We will cross the bridge to La Angostura in direction to the bay lakes Moreno, Nahuel Huapi and Lopez. Arrival in Punto Panorámico, a natural balcony with views of the peninsula of Llao-Llao and Moreno Lake. Overnight in Bariloche. **(B)**

DAY 5 (Tuesday) BARILOCHE- PUERTO PAÑUELO - PEULLA

Departure to Puerto Pañuelo. Cruise with a boat on the Lake Nahuel Huapi to Puerto Blest. After a short bus ride, we reach Lake Frías. Continue boat trip towards Chile. There we continue by bus through the Vicente Perez Rosales border point to Peulla, a small village located within the Vicente Perez National Park. Dinner and overnight **(B) (D)**

DAY 6 (Wednesday) PEULLA - NORTH LIMA - PUERTO MONTT

Departure with the Andean Crossing® service to Petrohué. Drive along the lake Petrohué. Enjoy the majestic views of the volcanoes Osorno, Tronador and Puntagudo. We sail on the beautiful emerald waters of the lake and we will see the native forests, volcanoes and waterfalls in the area. Next bus ride along the Lake Llanquihue until we reach Puerto Montt. Overnight. **(B)**

DAY 7 (Thursday) PUERTO MONTT

The day is at leisure. We recommend a trip to the beautiful city of Frutillar and Chiloé Island. Accommodation at hotel in Puerto Montt. **(B)**

Day 8 (Friday) PUERTO MONTT - SANTIAGO

Morning city tour in Puerto Montt. We start with a visit to the main square (Plaza de Armas) and the Cathedral. Then, we go to Melipulli Namsan, a mountain town that offers panoramic views over the harbour, Tenglo Island and the small bay of Reloncavi. The tour continues with a drive to the beaches of Pelluco and Chinguihue. Then we will see the fish market Angelmó with its small colorful boats contrasting with the backdrop of the island Tenglo. At the fish market in Angelmó the fresh catch of the morning can be bought or tasted directly in one of the many small food stalls. Right next door is a great souvenir and handicraft market. Continue to Puerto Varas, located on the southern shore of Lake Llanquihue. Puerto Varas is known as the "City of Roses" because of its beautiful gardens. It was founded in 1854 by German settlers and today is the German culture widely used there. Return to the hotel in Puerto Montt. The afternoon is at leisure.

Puerto Montt is also called the "gateway to Patagonia." Here begins the Carretera Austral and here the ships run to Tierra del Fuego, from the Strait of Magellan and the glaciers of Patagonia. In 1852, arrived here the first German settlers. Former President Manuel Montt had arranged the settlement as he had encouraged the Germans to come. A year later, the already half-finished city was officially established and called "Puerto Montt" after the president. Today, Puerto Montt has about 160,000 inhabitants and is the capital of the Region de los Lagos, as well as a major transportation hub. Transfer to the airport for your flight from Puerto Montt to Santiago. Reception at the airport and transfer to your hotel. Overnight **(B)**

DAY 9 (Saturday) SANTIAGO

Morning city tour in Santiago. We begin in the San Francisco Church, the oldest architectural expression of the capital. Then a visit to the Government Palace "La Moneda" and the Plaza de Armas (main square) where we can see important national buildings, including the Cathedral, the "Correo Central" (the post office) and the City Hall of Santiago. Drive to the Santa Lucia Hill where the city was founded in 1541. Then we cross the Mapocho River and drive through neighborhoods with a survey in the city. Return to the hotel. The afternoon is at leisure. Overnight. **(B)**



DAY 10 (Sunday) SANTIAGO - VALPARAÍSO - VIÑA DEL MAR

Departure towards the coast. On the way, it is possible to see the changing landscape and vegetation of Curacaví and Casablanca valleys and the Cordillera de la Costa (coastal mountains). Arrival in Valparaíso, Chile's main commercial harbor with its famous colored houses on the mountain. Visit to La Sebastiana, the old home of the Nobel Prize winner Pablo Neruda. We continue in the National Congress and by Pedro Montt Avenue, the Italian Park, Victoria Square and Cathedral. The excursion will continue along the coast from Valparaíso to Viña del Mar, also known as "The Garden City". Attractions are the flowers clockwork, Wulff Castle, the "Casino Municipal", the Peru-Allee, the Acapulco beach and Vergara Pier. Continue through the beaches of Las Salinas, Reñaca and Cochoa. Back to Santiago. Overnight. **(B) (L)**



DAY 11 (Monday) VIÑA DEL MAR - ALGARROBO - EL QUISCO - EL TABO - ISLA NEGRA - VIÑA DEL MAR

Breakfast at the hotel. Departure from the hotel towards the main beaches and resorts. Stop in Algarrobo, nice resort with a more interesting handicraft market. Then, visit from El Quisco and El Tabo, known for its calm sea. Continue to Isla Negra, where the Nobel Prize winner Pablo Neruda had his house. Back to the hotel in Viña del Mar. You can spend the rest of the day on the beach. **(B)**



DAY 12 (Tuesday) VIÑA DEL MAR - MENDOZA

Breakfast in the hotel. Early morning drive with our private bus to Mendoza. We cross the Andes again with breathtaking views of the snow-capped mountains. Along the Ruta, which connects Santiago de Chile with Mendoza, you pass small gorges and valleys with their picturesque villages. We also drive over the Paso Internacional Los Libertadores, the tolled newer route with the border crossing in the 3 km long tunnel at 3200 m altitude. If necessary, the bus drives the alternative and more beautiful old route over the Uspallata Pass. This is the epitome of a serpentine route and winds at about 3800 m high. Once in Mendoza, we drive to the hotel. Registration and overnight stay. The rest of the day is at your free disposal. **(B)**

DAY 13 (Wednesday) MENDOZA

In the morning, city tour and visit of the winery La Rural and the Wine Museum. Short break at the winery Zuccardi for wine tasting and lunch. Afternoon visit to the winery La Agricola around Mendoza. Back to the hotel. Overnight **(B) (L)**

DAY 14 (Thursday) MENDOZA

The day is at your leisure. You can visit the city of Mendoza. Mendoza is located 700m above sea level at foot of the Andean Cordillera, which at this point has the highest elevations (Cerro Aconcagua 6,962 m). The landscape is a barren dry steppe, but which is irrigated in the immediate vicinity of the city, so viticulture is possible. **(B)**

DAY 15 (Friday) BUENOS AIRES - MENDOZA - RETURN FLIGHT

Breakfast at hotel. Early transfer to the airport for your flight to Buenos Aires and connecting flight back home. **(B)** ahren wir zum Hotel. Registrierung und Übernachtung. Der restliche Tag steht Ihnen zur freien Verfügung. **(F)**
