- 1) Private bus for the event: Circuit buses will depart every five minutes from the Hard Rock Cafe located at Plaça Catalunya, 21. The bus service will run from 9:30 am to 6:30 pm. INCLUDED IN THE PRICE OF YOUR TICKET.
- 2) Public transportation with RENFE: Take trains with final destination Mataró, Calella or Blanes from the Clot, Arc de Triomf, Plaça Catalunya or Sants Estació train stations. Once you get off at Premià de Mar, you will have to catch the bus to Illa Fantasia (every 15 minutes).

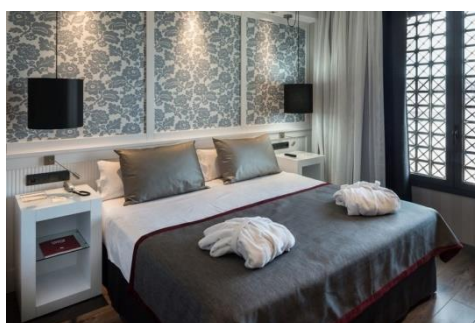
